The Camp Committee needs your prayer as major decisions will have to be made about the future of our camp as our date in July has been usurped by other activities at Norman Park.

The Senior Adult Rally was hosted marvelously by Beacon Baptist Church. The attendance was approximately 95 from 11 churches. The food was great (and so much) and the church did such a good job serving everyone, arranging the entertainment, and blessing many with door prizes.

The Executive Committee met July 21 with 28 attending of which five were pastors representing 17 churches. We heard good reports from our teams and ministries indicating how active our association is. The Executive Committee approved the action of the Personnel Committee to employ Tonia Clark as our Ministry Assistant/Clerk/Treas. She is on a steep learning curve, but is meeting the challenge. They also approved the MBA giving First Baptist, Acree, one thousand dollars for flood recovery. We have received to date a total of \$3,880 from six churches.
