First, I want to share with you that not only are we waiting to get the "match" from the adoption agency for our son and his wife's second child from China, we have been informed by our daughter and husband that she is pregnant (due the end of March). Wow, we are working on having a total of three grandchildren within six months! Leanne (our daughter) informed us on my birthday.

What a great birthday present!

The Disciple Now Weekend was a great success with over 180 youth registering from nine churches. Thanks to the MBA Youth Team for making this happen: John Evans, Brian Scott, Mark Spragins, Brent Willis, and Scott Yaikow (chairman).

Many of you know that I was called by GBC Disaster Relief to go to Mississippi as a Disaster Relief Chaplain. Terrell Ruis (GBC Ministry Resource Consultant) and I first went to Lucedale where there was a feeding unit and a clean-up and recovery team. Since there were several chaplains present, we moved to First Baptist Church, Pascagoula to minister. A clean-up and recovery team and a feeding unit were present there also. Over 11,000 meals were being prepared daily for the victims. There was a chainsaw team and a mud-out team going out daily. With 800 jobs already approved, the applications had to be cut off. Terrell and I worked mostly in the distribution center set up by First Baptist. Victims could get water, ice, hygiene products, cleaning supplies, baby needs, and food. All of this was dependent on what had been donated by generous companies, businesses, churches, and individuals. All of the people working in the distribution center were also volunteers. God was really in control! When it looked like we would be short of volunteers or something the victims needed, God would provide within a short time. We were also able to give out Bibles (when we finally got some) and tracks. We had brief moments to give an encouraging word and point them to Jesus. The line for getting these goods was often a mile or more long.

You can be proud of the North American Mission Board Disaster Relief (the third largest relief organization behind the Red Cross and Salvation Army) as well as the GBC Disaster Relief. One person said what many others thought or expressed, "We can't find the Red Cross or FEMA, but the Baptists are here!" There will be the need for many rebuild teams to begin going in the next few weeks. Go ahead and register online at www.namb.net or call 1-800-462-8657 to let NAMB know of your readiness to send a team or teams to assist a church.
