We also want to congratulate Michael Catt, pastor of Sherwood Baptist Church, for being elected as President of the Southern Baptist Pastor's Conference. We also praise the Lord for pastors who lead their churches to impact our world for Jesus Christ.

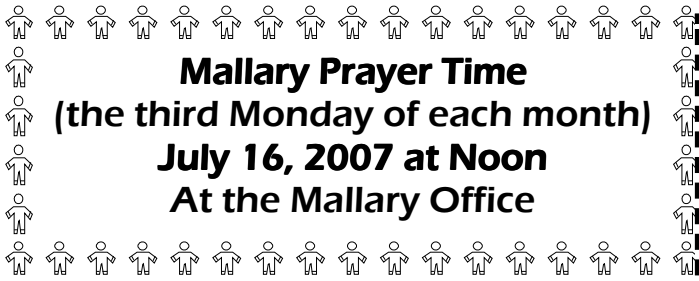
Other churches are also planning BYBCs. Will you pray for God to use them in a mighty way to reach those not normally reached by our churches?

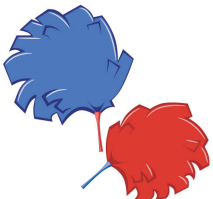
