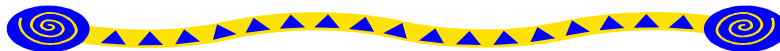

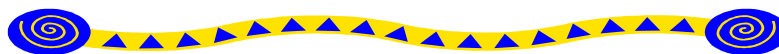

Our Uttermost Parts of the World

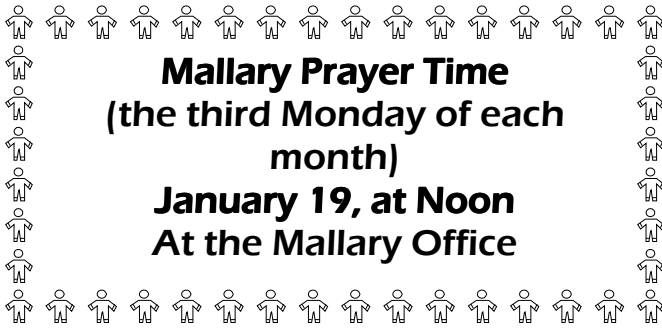
1. Pray for the International Mission Board and its missionaries.
